## Explanation of changes and other important information

We changed your RRSP/PRPP deduction from \$10,000 to \$4,308, which is the maximum allowed. For more information, see Guide T4040, RRSPs and Other Registered Plans for Retirement.

We will automatically calculate your goods and services tax/harmonized sales tax credit and any related provincial credit based on your family net income, province of residence, marital status, and qualified children. If you qualify for any credit for July 2016 to June 2017, we will let you know in July.

You may have to pay a monthly tax of 1% on your RRSP/PRPP excess contributions because your unused RRSP/PRPP contributions (amount B) are more than your RRSP/PRPP deduction limit for 2016 (amount A), as noted on "Your 2016 RRSP/PRPP Deduction Limit Statement." Ref. Your letter dated May 12, 2016 and Abbey Manak's letter dated July 18, 2016.

You must understand that NO PERSON HAS AUTHORITY TO MAKE PAYMENTS FROM ANOTHER PERSON'S ACCOUNT, without COURT ORDER.

Please, follow the rule of LAW, and **return my money back**, or let me know under what **authority**, you have a **RIGHT** to make a payment from my account, without my consent. Thanks for your cooperation.

If you fail to provide me with the **authority** I requested, I will be obliged to publicize **your conduct** for the PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC. As you may know, unauthorized tampering with the account of a person is tantamount to THEFT.

This is response to your request of May 20, 2016. We apologize for the delay in replying.

We are unable to review your account and respond to your enquiry without obtaining your social insurance number (SIN).

Any time you are initiating contact with the Canada Revenue Agency, either in writing or by telephone, you are required to provide your full SIN to ensure correct identification.

However, we can provide information regarding the Refund Set-off program that is general in nature.

The Refund Set-Off program is a Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) initiative under which tax refunds of individuals are applied to pay debts owed under other federal, provincial or territorial programs. Refunds are applied to any amounts owing on your income tax account first and any balance is then transferred to amounts owing to other agencies.

The CRA has responsibility and accountability for the collections of these debts. Section 164(2) of the Income Tax Act allows the CRA to withhold income tax refunds, as well as Goods and Services Tax/Harmonized Sales Tax (GST/HST) credit payments, to recover debts owed to the Government. The CRA does not receive any details regarding your debt and does not have authority to adjust or cancel the amount of debt.

If you do not agree with the debt or want the debt cancelled, you need to contact B.C. Consumption Taxes directly.
